## Deadline for CoC NOFO Competition Submission of Consolidated Application: September 30, 2022

Reminder: All project applications must be ranked. Please carefully read the <u>HUD 2022 NOFO</u> for details on eligible activities. The following information for submissions of new and renewal requests will help you plan your submission.

## Deadline for Renewal Project and New Project Letters of Intent and Housing First Questionnaires: August 15, 2022 - 5PM

## Renewal Project Letter of Intent Submission Criteria

All Renewal Applications must complete/submit the following information with the organization's Letter of Intent:

- 1. Housing First Questionnaire
- 2. Most recent grant close-out for the project
- 3. Last closed out Annual Performance Report (APR) for the project (including screenshot of final submission date/time)
- 4. Complete and submit the commitment form for Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) and Coordinated Entry System (CES) participation.
- 5. Organization's latest completed Financial Audit or IRS Form 990
- 6. eLLocs print out showing minimum quarterly grant draws over the year-term of the grant
- 7. Monitoring results (if your program has been monitored by HUD over the last 12 months) or statement from your Approving Official stating that your project(s) have not been monitored.
- 8. List of Organization's board members with person with lived experience highlighted

New Project Letter of Intent Submission Criteria (all items listed above and the following):

- 1. 501(c)3 Designation, or evidence of government entity
- 2. Threshold Checklist complete, signed copy
- 3. Performance Outcomes new project rating criteria completed

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION:** Agency with approved letters of intent for application submission will be notified <u>as soon as project applications are available</u> on the HUD Exchange. All project applicants must have an updated SAMS Registration including the organization's Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) number.
